NYC Emerging Artists Fine Art Competition

DEADLINE: November 23, 2007

Gallerie Icosahedron Emerging Artists Fine Art Competition is intended for those who wish to receive exposure in the rigorous New York City art scene and market. We wish to offer fresh talent an opportunity to exhibit in NYC. We are one of the handful of galleries that specialize in Visionary Realism, Surrealism, and Visionary Art in general: however there are no rules to our selection since excellence in art often means breaking all the rules.

Please visit our web site at www.icosahedron.com and choose the "Artists" link to view the artists' pages to determine whether your work will be appropriate for Gallerie Icosahedron before you enter the contest. You must be at least 18 years of age to enter this contest. International applicants are encouraged.

The exhibit will run from January 9- January 31, 2008 at Gallerie Icosahedron. Gallerie Icosahedron is a fine art gallery and it has also become a premiere venue for classical and cutting edge contemporary music and performance. Our concert calendar has included luminaries that have performed at the Metropolitan opera and Carnegie Hall. We are hosting a weekly concert series designed to attract audiences interested in Jazz, New Opera and traditional classical music. Art and music lovers are drawn to Gallerie Icosahedron for the excellence of both the visionary art and the virtuosity of the performers. Gallerie Icosahedron is the vanguard of a cultural revolution that will unite both music and art. We believe that creative communication is freedom's sanctuary. We are a street level art gallery located in the heart of the prestigious Tribeca section in Manhattan, NYC.

The opening reception will include an open bar and we will send invitations and announcement to everyone on our extensive mailing list. The opening will be held on Thursday evening January 10th, 2008, and the show will continue until January 31st, 2008. There will be a musical performance before the opening.

Calendar:

- Submissions must be post marked on or before November 26th, 2007.
- All those who have entered the NYC Emerging Artist Fine Art Competition will receive a reply on or before December 9th, 2007. Winners of the contest will be announced the

first week of December and will receive an artist's agreement in the regular mail shortly thereafter.

- January 5th, 8th and 9th, 2008 -- artwork to be delivered (international artists are responsible for all customs issues).
- February 1st and 2nd, 2008 – art work to be picked up.

Image Submissions

- Artists in the US: \$50 for three images; \$5 additional images.
- Artists outside of the US: \$60 for three images; \$5 additional images.
- A flat fee of \$50 is charged for the submission of a web address (URL).

International Submissions must use PayPal ONLY. International submissions must include an extra \$2.00 for return postage and handling. The artist must supply a self-address stamped envelope.

Note: If a self-addressed envelope is not included, your submission will not be returned. Gallerie Icosahedron will not be responsible for lost materials. Please remember to make copies of everything you send. Do not send original artwork!

Acceptable Image Submissions:

CD:

Acceptable formats: jpeg, riff or tiff.

Label files with artist's name and number corresponding to entry form, please mark artist's name on the CD itself

Slides: *Digital images preferred for possible publication; only send slides if you do not have digital images of your work*

Standard 2" x 2", plastic or paper mounts.

Prints or Photographs: All material must EASILY fit into an 8.5" by 11" envelope.

Web Submissions: Send web address ONLY.

Remember to fill in the image sheet even if you are sending just the URL.

Eligibility

- Original works in any medium.
- Works must be ready for hanging, and clearly labeled with the artists name and contact information – NO SPECIAL HANGING - NO DRILLING INTO WALLS - all work must be able to hang directly from a typical hanger, such as a nail.
- 2 or 3 dimensional works, free-standing installations.
- Acceptance of works may be withdrawn with proper notice, at the discretion of Gallerie Icosahedron.
- No substitutions of accepted works.
- All accepted works will remain on display during the duration of the exhibit.

- Shipping and retrieval of artwork is the responsibility of the artist. Pick-up of artwork by an agency to be by pre-paid COD or waybill to be included with artwork. It is the responsibility of artists shipping from abroad to research customs requirements

Insurance and Liability

Artists are responsible for insuring their work in transit. Gallerie Icosahedron will not be responsible for loss or damage to work. We take extensive measures to ensure the safety of your work and we work diligently to protect our mutual investment in your important artworks. Please make sure to inquire about insurance from your shipping company so that work is not damaged in the process of packaging or transit.

Sales and Copyright

All pieces will be for sale, a 35% commission will be charged on works sold. Your entry grants permission to Gallerie Icosahedron for use of images on all promotional materials.

Prizes:

First Prize: 15-25 pieces exhibited (depending on the sizes) from January 9th thru 30th, 2008, prominently displayed in the front window and front section of Gallerie Icosahedron.

A full color insert of an image of our choice in the NYC Gallery Guide.

A full color image on the Gallery Guide Web Calendar.

A DVD slide show on our flat panel monitor in our front window exhibiting the portfolio of the artists work.

A presence on our web site and a year's representation at Gallerie Icosahedron.

Third Prize:
